

RMHA Equipment Policy

Jerseys

- Coaches/Managers are required to sign out the team jerseys for the season they are also responsible and are to ensure that they are properly cared for until returned.
- Game jerseys are NEVER to be worn during practice.
- Game jerseys are NEVER to be worn for any other function other than a Renfrew Minor Hockey Association (RMHA) game or team event. For example, jerseys are not to be worn for outdoor hockey, public skating, hockey development sessions, etc. Jerseys cannot be used for an unsanctioned event.
- Should a Home or Away jersey be lost or damaged, the coaching staff will be
 responsible for replacement, at the discretion of the Equipment Manager.
 Replacement costs are \$150 per jersey to RMHA. If a jersey is damaged during a
 game, it should be reported to the equipment manager following the game for
 assessment of the damages to the jersey.
- Team jerseys should be washed throughout the year and hung out to dry. DO NOT USE DRYERS.
- Jersey are to be kept in provided team jersey bags throughout the season to ensure that they will stay in good condition.
- Only 1 sponsorship name bar per jersey, sponsorship name bars are on home and/or away jerseys depending on the level of sponsorship.
- No last name bars on RMHA Jersey's
- Removal of Sponsorship bars, A's, C's Great care must be taken when removing the Sponsorship bars to ensure no damage has been done to the jerseys.
- Jerseys are to be returned to RMHA in the same condition as they were handed out.
 This includes removing puck marks, rips/tears, jersey strings and placed in jersey bag with hangers.
- Teams that do not follow this policy will result in a loss of RMHA provided ice times as well be subject to monetary holdback of funds.

Socks

- RMHA hockey socks are required as part of the team uniform
- The purchased of game socks will be done through RMHA players registered in U9-U18 will require one (1) pair of Blue Socks and For Rep B players they will also require to purchase one (1) pair of white RMHA hockey socks for the season.



Exceptions to the U11 house teams that will be provided matching socks provided with their atomic jerseys.

• Additional / replacement Blue or white RMHA socks may be purchased from the RMHA Equipment Manager.

Pucks/Puck Bag/First Aid Kit

- RMHA has provided each team with 20 pucks and a puck bag for games U9-U18.
 RMHA provides practice pucks at the back of the rink in the blue milk crate. Blue pucks for U7 and Black for U9-U18
- RMHA has also provided each team with the access to all training aids in the yard shed off to the side of the rink. Teams are responsible for returning all training aids back to the storage area neatly, failure to do so could result in loss of use of these aids and or loss of ice times.
- RMHA will provide each team with a First Aid Kit for their trainers.
